The school is approved by the Puerto Rico State Approving Agency to provide academic training to the students under the various GI Bill® programs.

Public Law 115-407, Section 103:

Effective August 1, 2019:

Section 103 of Public Law 115-407, the Veterans Benefits Transition Act of 2018, prohibits denial of access and/or other penalties against recipients of Post 9/11 GI Bill® benefits or Veterans Readiness and Employment benefits. Effective August 1, 2019, any individual who is entitled to educational assistance under Chapter 31, Veterans Readiness and Employment, or Chapter 33, Post 9/11 GI Bill® benefits, must be permitted to attend or participate in the course of education during the period beginning on the date on which the individual provides to the Universidad Teológica del Caribe (Theological University of the Caribbean) a certificate of eligibility for entitlement to educational assistance under the aforementioned and ending on the earlier of the following dates:

- The date on which payment from Veterans Affairs (VA) is made to the University, or
- 90 days after the date Universidad Teológica del Caribe (Theological University of the Caribbean) certified tuition and fees following the receipt of the certificate of eligibility.

The Universidad Teológica del Caribe (Theological University of the Caribbean) will not impose any penalty (including the assessment of late fees; the denial of access to classes, libraries, or other institutional facilities; or the requirement that a covered individual borrow additional funds) on any covered individual because of the individual's inability to meet their financial obligations to Universidad Teológica del Caribe (Theological University of the Caribbean) due to the delayed disbursement funding from VA under Chapter 31 or 33. Penalties can be imposed after the first of the two above-mentioned dates passes.

Covered individuals may also be required to provide additional information to the Universidad Teológica del Caribe (Theological University of the Caribbean) Veterans School Certifying Official such as a Certificate of Eligibility, DD Form 214, or proof of the Transfer of Entitlement request and/or other related documents.
